How WOMEN GIVING GRANTS works:

Any women can make a difference in the lives of people suffering from disease and poverty. Here are the 5 easy steps that show you how:

1. Pick a name for your group — for example, "Women Giving Grants, Bucks County, Pennsylvania." Ask a few of your friends to join the group.
2. Your group reviews three worthwhile projects for possible funding. The Face-to-Face AIDS Project provides real stories, photographs, and videos for your group to use in learning about who they might give a grant to, and for helping get new members to join.
3. Every member of your group contributes \$500. Your group meets to discuss strategies to increase the number of new members.
4. Your group invites as many women to join by December 10, 2010. After a discussion, each member then votes for her favorite project.

5. The donations are sent to Face-to-Face, which takes the grant to its recipient in early 2011. Update reports are provided to your group so that you know that your efforts have improved the lives of many.



The beauty of WOMEN GIVING GRANTS is that by working together, you and your colleagues can make a significant, meaningful impact with your \$500 contributions. 20 women would deliver a \$10,000 grant, which would dramatically improve the lives of thousands of Cambodians and Malawians suffering from HIV/AIDS and poverty.
